POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, W. L. Allison, of Greenville, South Carolina, do hereby constitute and appoint my daughter, Lucille A. Turner, of Greenville, South Carolina, as my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead, with full powers to have and to exercise the following powers and authorities:

1. To sell or exchange and convey any property, whether real, personal or mixed, which I may now own or hereafter acquire, specifically including stocks, bonds or securities.

2. To sign checks withdrawing or transferring funds from any bank in which money may be deposited in my name or with others, and to accept, collect and endorse any checks, drafts or instruments for the payment of money; to withdraw or transfer funds from any savings account in which money may be deposited in my name or jointly with others.

3. To borrow money and execute notes or other instruments evidencing payment, and to pledge as security therefor any stocks, bonds, securities or property which I may own, in order to secure said loans.

4. To collect any monies which may become due me and to give receipts therefor.

5. To be my lawful proxy, and to vote any stock or security I may own, or hereafter acquire, and to exercise all rights, privileges and options of said stock and securities.

6. To invest and re-invest from time to time any funds which I may have, in her absolute discretion.

7. And, generally, to manage and control my property, and to execute any and all instruments necessary or expedient for that purpose as I might do, if personally present.
