Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, William Thomas Taylor

in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, and correction of deed recorded in the State aforesaid, Vol. 789, at page 283. DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Willie Ray Robinson and Syble M. Robinson, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying, and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Chick Springs Township, near the City of Greer, on the West side of James Road, being shown and designated as containing 1.84 acres, on a plat of property prepared for R.B. Taylor, by T.T. Dill, Surveyor, dated December 1, 1965, duly recorded in Plat Book 666 at page 346, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING on an iron pin on the West side of James Road, the Southeast corner of said tract, and running thence S 25-00 W 194 feet to an iron pin; thence N 72-10 W 307.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N 35-00 E 583.2 feet to an iron pin on the West side of James Road; thence with the West side of said Road, S 3-20 E 185 feet to a bend, and S 2-00 E 80 feet to an iron pin, the Northeast corner of a .56 acre lot previously conveyed to Smith; thence with the line of Smith as follows: S 76-40 W 143 feet, S 18-20 W 118 feet, S 74-12 E 144 feet, and N 24-20 E 130.5 feet to an iron pin on the West side of James Road; thence therewith, S 12-46 E 57.8 feet to the point of beginning. The above described lot being the greater part of Tract No. 4 on a plat prepared for R.B. Taylor, by T.T. Dill, Surveyor, dated May 11, 1964. Also being a part of the same conveyed to R.B. Taylor by deed recorded in Vol. 257 at page 254. R.B. Taylor conveyed an undivided one-half interest in same to William Thomas Taylor by deed dated January 28, 1965.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
