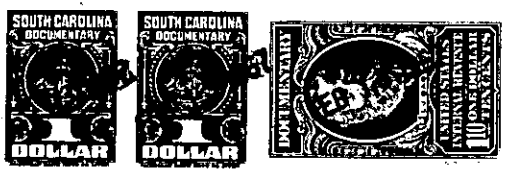
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, S. T. Turner, Sr. of the County and State

in consideration of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto George F. Morgan, his heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, Township of Chick Springs, containing one (1) acre more or less, situated on the the West side of Highway 253, immediately south and adjacent to a point where Beverdam Creek passes under said Highway, and being more particularly described according to a plat thereof made by Carolina Engineering & Surveying Company for George F. Morgan, dated February 10, 1967, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a pin in the center of Highway No. 253, and in the center of the bridge over Beaverdam Creek, and running thence with the center of said Highway, S. 7-07 E. 155 feet to a point; thence N. 87-30 W. 39 feet to a point; thence, N.87-30 W. 180 feet to a point; thence N. 7-0W. 387 feet to a point in the center of Beaverdam Creek; thence with the center of Beaverdam Creek as the line, S. 41-42 E. 305.2 feet to a point; thence S. 65- 0 E., continuing with the center of said Creek 50 feet to the center of Highway No. 253, and the center of the Bridge over Beaverdam Creek, the point of beginning.
