## POWER OF ATTORNEY



## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, Stanley I. Coleman, of No. 23-A South Main Street, Town of Travelers Rest, Greenville County, South Carolina, have named, made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do hereby name, make, constitute and appoint, Mrs. Virginia F. Coleman, of the same address, my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead:

1. To ask, sue for, recover and receive all such sums of money, debts, accounts, interest, dividends (whether in stock or in cash), annuities and demands whatsoever, as are now or hereafter shall become due, owing or payable to me; and to make, sign, execute and deliver receipts, acquittances, releases or other discharges therefor; to satisfy and cancel or extend or renew any mortgages of real estate or personal property.

2. To make deposits of money for me or for my account and to draw checks against the same or against any account or deposit in my name now or at any time in any bank, savings and loan association or other financial institution; to indorse any checks, notes, certificates of stock or other securities, or to transfer, assign, hypothecate, pledge or sell and convert the same into money.

3. To rent, lease, grant, bargain, sell and release and/or mortgage any and all lands, tenements and hereditaments upon such terms, conditions and covenants and for such price as she may deem proper; to sign, seal, execute and deliver any deed of conveyance, note, mortgage or other instrument of writing and to do every other thing necessary and proper in order to carry into effect any deed, option, agreement of sale, mortgage or other instrument of writing, in such manner that all my right, title and interest in and to the land and appurtenances included in such deed of conveyance, option, agreement of sale, mortgage or other instrument of writing may be effectually and absolutely conveyed and assured to any purchaser or purchasers or mortgagee, his, her or its heirs, successors and assigns forever, or to such other person or persons and for such other estate or estates therein as my attorney shall direct or appoint.

4. To purchase, receive, receipt for and take possession of lands, tenements and hereditaments, stocks, bonds, notes, securities, money and any other property, real or personal, upon such terms, conditions and covenants as my said attorney shall deem proper.
