

IT is understood and agreed that the said George Hopkins and Della B. Hopkins will use this easement in common with any other persons that may be granted a like right by the grantors herein, their Heirs and Assigns.

THE said George Hopkins and Della B. Hopkins, their Heirs and Assigns shall have the right at all times to enter upon the said strip of land for the purpose of making any necessary repairs to the said roadway and to cut and keep clear of said roadway all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, interfere with the proper maintenance and use of said roadway.

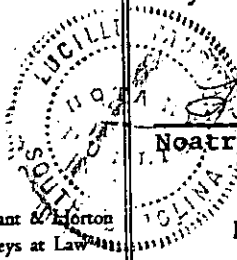
