C., the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, (I) (we) hereby grant unto said City of Greenville, a right-of-way or easement along, over or under (my) (our) property for the purpose of: Installing and maintaining a sanitary sewer line, said right of way to extend 15 feet on each side of the center line during construction and a permanent right of way of five feet on each side of the center line, of said sewer line as installed, and being 80 feet, more or less, in length.

Together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same.

Said property is described as follows: Located in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 188 on a Plat of Sherwood Forest, recorded in Plat Book GG at Pages 70 and 71 and being situate on the northern side of Nottingham Road. Said right of way is to extend across the northern portion of the lot, which is also shown as Lot 60, Blk 1, Sheet 267 on the County Block Book. See Deed Book 526 at Page 93.
