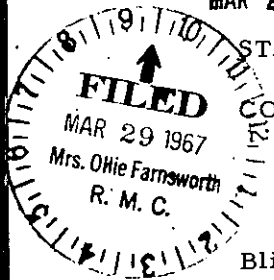

POWER OF ATTORNEY

Murph, my attorney in fact, to enter into and take possession of the contents, if she desires, of my lock-box at Peoples' National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina. All of which the said Jessie B. Murph my attorney in fact, is authorized to do as completely as I could do.
