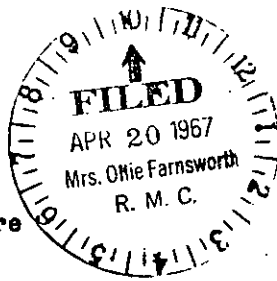

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

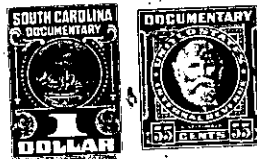
J. G. Stroud and Essie E. Stroud, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Paris Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 54, as shown on a Plat of Bellwood Estates, Section 1, dated May, 1950 by Dalton & Neves Engineering Company, recorded in the R. Silver Lake Drive, the point of beginning.
