

perogative shall devolve upon his successor. The spiritual head of the corporation shall perform the duties and have all the rights and authority of a board of trustees under the laws of the State of Georgia.

V

The powers of the corporation shall be as follows:

a. The corporation shall have all of the rights, powers and privileges customary or proper for a religious, charitable, recreational or educational corporation, as well as those herein specifically set out;

b. May receive donations by gifts, bequests or devise and agree upon the conditions thereof with donors or their agents or trustees for the purpose provided in this charter;

c. May from time to time invest the funds of the corporation in such property, real or personal, as the spiritual head in his sound discretion may determine, irrespective of whether such investments may be legal investments for trust funds under the laws of Georgia;

d. May buy, own, hold, manage, lease and sell real and personal property, including stocks, bonds, evidences of indebtedness and other choses in action;

e. May buy, own, hold, manage, lease and sell housing and commercial facilities which are to be operated exclusively for the purpose of this corporation and the profits of which are not to inure to the benefit of any incorporator, trustee or individual;

f. May organize and operate scientific and cultural enterprises for the benefit of the corporation and coordinate with the purposes of the corporation to administer to the general welfare; and shall have all other powers and authority generally granted corporations of similar nature under the laws of this State, subject to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.

VI

Petitioner desires the privilege of establishing offices elsewhere, both within and without the State of Georgia, such as might be necessary to serve the needs of the corporation.
