

It is further understood that the owner is to have the right to cultivate and use this right of way strip of land provided such use thereon shall not interfere with the proper maintenance and free access to the pipe line or lines to be installed under this agreement. No buildings or other structures shall be placed on said right of way.

The payment above specified covers compensation for the easement or right of way, and also covers all claims for damages, including crops growing on the right of way during the year 1967, along said right of way resulting from construction of the pipe line or lines to be laid.

It is further agreed that incase of future damages to property or crop, due from an accident on the pipe line that THE CITY OF GREENVILLE shall pay all damages.

The undersigned agrees to release and give to THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, actual physical possession of the premises above described not later than the 1st day of April, 1967.

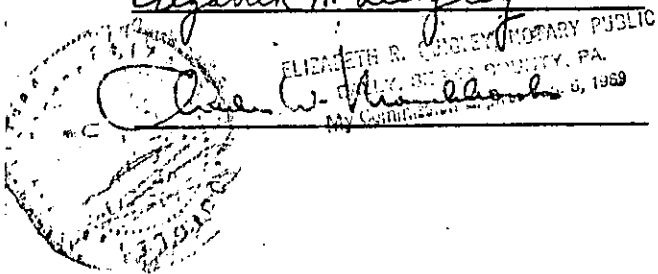
