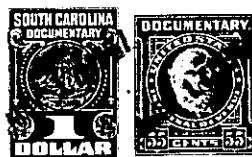

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the southeastern side of Yorkshire Drive (formerly Mable Avenue) in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, as shown on plat of property of Truluck and Hartness dated May, 1967, by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Q Q Q, Page 135, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Yorkshire Drive (formerly Mable Avenue), said iron pin being at the northeastern corner of property this date conveyed by the grantor to Thomas P. Hartness and Prudy Jo Hartness, and running thence with the line of Hartness, S. 47-08 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 42-52 E. 13.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-08 W. 200 feet to an iron pin, the southeastern side of Yorkshire Drive (formerly Mable Avenue); thence with the southeastern side of Yorkshire Drive (formerly Mable Avenue), S. 42-52 W. 13.7 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.

This is a part of the land conveyed to W. M. Edwards by deed of E. Inman, Master, dated September 15, 1962, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 707, at page 365.

This property is conveyed subject to easements, rights of way and restrictions applicable to said property, including, but not limited to, that certain Duke Power transmission right of way as shown on plat of property of Truluck and Hartness.
