(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James H. Copeland and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of a County road leading westward from the Suber Road, containing 4.43 acres, more or less, and being Lot No. A-5 of the subdivision of Tract "A" of the Annie L. Copeland Estate according to survey and plat by Campbell & Clarkson, dated May, 1962, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the road, northeast corner of the lot herein, and running thence S. 2-07 W. 1878.5 feet to a point in the Southern Railway track; thence S. 74-15 W. 28.3 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. A-4; thence along the line of Lot No. A-4, N. 2-43 W. 1765.9 feet to a point in the road; thence along said road, N. 55-49 E. 216 feet to the beginning corner.

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
