

(\$650.00) Dollars paid to it by the said Grace Steele Prevost likewise does hereby relinquish and transfer any right, title and interest that it has in and to this street and by action of its City Council has empowered the City Attorney to consent to this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the South Carolina Highway Department and the City of Greenville pay to Mrs. Grace Steele Prevost the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred (\$2,600.00) Dollars, and in turn Mrs. Grace Steele Prevost pay to the City of Greenville the sum of Six Hundred Fifty (\$650.00) Dollars, and upon such payment the said South Carolina Highway Department and the City of Greenville shall consent to this order transferring all right, title and interest in and to that piece and parcel of land as more fully described as Parcel A on the plat hereto attached located between the new proposed Academy Street and Pendleton Street.

That upon the conditions as hereinabove set forth being met, it is ordered that this matter be and the same hereby is ended.
