KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, W. C. Bumby, of Greenville County

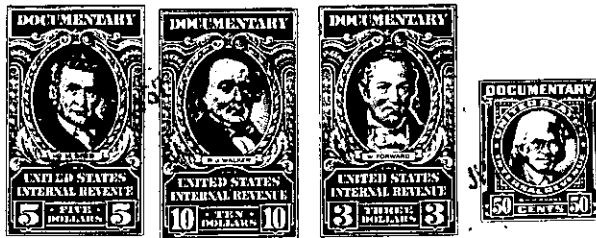
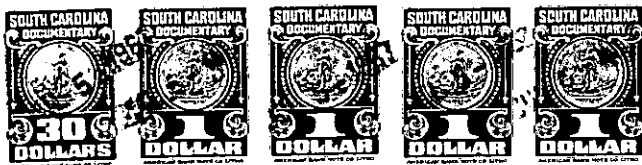
in consideration of Sixteen Thousand, Seven Hundred and No/100 (\$16,700.00)-----Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Wallace N. Evans and Martha D. Evans, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Hunt's Bridge Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 37 of a subdivision known as Indian Hills, property of J. Frank Williams, et al., as shown on a plat thereof being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at page 11, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Hunt's Bridge Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 36 and 37, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 82-35 E. 140 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 35; thence with the line of Lot No. 35, N. 14-30 E. 107.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 37 and 38; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 82-35 W. 180 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Hunt's Bridge Road; thence with said road, S. 7-25 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by C. A. Talley by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 666, page 110.
