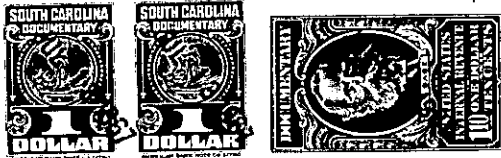
Or whom the same may in anywise concern, I, RALPH W. DRAKE, as Judge of the Court of Probate
