All of my undivided interest in and to all that tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Oaklawn Township, originally containing 77.5 acres, more or less, and now containing 76.5 acres, more or less, and described as follows:

Beginning on stone at south west corner and thence S. 83.0 E. along H. T. Rice's land 31.79 to stone 3x; thence N. 29 1/2 E. 26.00 to stone 3x; thence N. 79 W. 32.00 to stone 3x; thence N. 36 E. 5.50 to stone 3x; thence N. 54 W. 5.00 to stone 3x; thence S. 36.00 W. 29.20 to beginning corner.
