which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 20th day of

April, A. D. 1967, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the **Greenville Piedmont**, a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is **LEGAL SERVICES AGENCY OF GREENVILLE, INC.**

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is **Greenville, South Carolina**

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is

To engage in the administration of legal services assistance to the indigent of Greenville County, South Carolina, as comprehended under the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 or similar or related legislation, and any amendments thereto; provided, however, that any such things which this Corporation may do shall be done and any powers which this Corporation may have shall be used only in furtherance of exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or as hereafter amended;
