Howell all that piece, parcel, and tract of land lying situate and being in the State and County aforesaid, and in Bates Township; with the following meets and bounds to wit: Beginning at Iron Pin on the road North and running South for 16 ft. 3 in.; thence West 12 ft.; thence North 16 ft. 3 in.; thence East 12 ft. to beginning Iron Pin. This plot contains 195 square feet. It joins the Hellams plot on South; the road on North; the Bates plot on the East; and the Carter plot on the West.

This is a part of the land conveyed to us by our mother, Mrs. Minnie V. Hellams. This land to be used for burial purposes only. The said property lies in close proximity to the Ebenezer Baptist Church Cemetery.
