WHEREAS, A. W. Hill County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against Earlie Pierce, Estate

WHEREAS, by virtue and authority of said warrants George F. Miller the delinquent tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 11th day of August 19 66 seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of September during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to W. W. Belue and his heirs and assigns, the purchaser(s), hereinafter known as "grantee(s)," and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Two Thousand and NO/100 Dollars and gave a receipt for said purchase money to him; and

WHEREAS, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayer(s), or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, George F. Miller, Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Two Thousand and NO/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantee(s), F. W. Belue

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee(s), F. W. Belue

his heirs and assigns: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on an iron pin, running thence S. 56 E. 1272 chains to a stake; thence N. 45, 35 E. 1.73 chains to a stone; thence N. 32½ W. 4.05 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 76½ W. 9.73 chains to the beginning corner, containing two and forty one hundredths acres (2.40)
