the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto G.W. Darby, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the Ware Place, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 on a plat of property of J.B. and Ellis King, made by C.O. Riddle, Registered Surveyor, dated October, 1965, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Old Hundred Road where the same is intersected by an unnamed street, and running thence with the north side of Old Hundred Road N. 64-45 E. 125 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence with the common line of said lots N. 25-15 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot 17; thence S. 64-45 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of an unnamed street; thence with the eastern side of said unnamed street S. 25-15 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-15 E. 35.4 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the following restriction:

No dwelling shall be erected on this lot, costing less than \$6900.00 to construct.


