sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) and love and affection for my wife and children herein named, to me paid by Lois W. Collins, R. C. Collins, Jr., Elizabeth C. Rouse, Bobby Joe Collins, and Jack E. Collins, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lois W. Collins, R. C. Collins, Jr., Elizabeth C. Rouse, Bobby Joe Collins, and Jack E. Collins, their heirs or assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Dunklin Township, containing 229.29 acres, more or less, being known as the "Scott Place" and located on the Little Horse Creek Road, approximately ten miles from Honea Path, South Carolina, and according to a recent survey by J. C. Hill, dated July, 1965, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Trayham Road in the line of property of grantor and property now or formerly in the name of Thomason and Cothran and running thence N. 14-30 E. 561 feet to a point; thence N. 65-0 E. 1,925 feet to an old stone; thence continuing with line of property of grantor and Thomason and Cothran, N. 25-08 W. 1,396 feet to a point in line of property of grantor and Knight; thence running with said line, S. 81-50 W. 1,445 feet to a corner; thence S. 15-30 E. 212 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 49-0 W. 136.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-0 W. 329.7 feet to an iron pin; thence a line crossing W. Ridgeway Road and continuing with the line of Knight and grantor herein, S. 82-45 W. 3,861 feet to a stone; thence with Horton and Knight property, S. 4-15 W. 708.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of grantor and property now or formerly owned by McCullough, S. 81-30 E. 1,032.7 feet to a stone and iron pin in the branch; thence with the branch as the line, 2,385 feet, more or less, to a stone; thence S. 78-E. 990 feet to a stone; thence with Thomason and Cothran property, N. 26-45 E. 1,056 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said line, N. 21-30 E. 132 feet to a point on the southwestern side of said Trayham Road.

There is a tract of 16.71 acres located in approximately the center of the above described tract, said tract being owned by Gambrell as shown by deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 558 at Page 455. Said tract is excluded from and in no way affects this conveyance.
