(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Wesley Snyder, his Heirs and Assigns, forever;

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the Northeast side of Merlocke Drive in the City of Greenville in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of property of Jean Lockerby Brooks, recorded in Plat Book Q, Page 47 in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Merlocke Drive, joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, and running thence with the line of Lot 2, N 53-45 E, 157 feet to a pin; thence S 36-15 E, 60 feet to a pin; thence S 53-45 W, 157 feet to a pin on the Northeast side of Merlocke Drive; thence with the Northeast side of Merlocke Drive, N 36-15 W, 60 feet to the point of beginning.
