race, and is sold and conveyed subject to all rules and regulations printed on the back hereof, and any additions or
amendments for the government of the Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted property to the said Mrs. W. G. Hewkins, her
heirs and assigns, forever; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations above referred to.
And GREENVILLE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION, for itself, and successors and assigns, covenants with
the said Mrs. W. G. Hawkins that the lot shall receive general care as
specified in Rule No. 10 on the reverse hereof to which reference is made.
And GREENVILLE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and for-
ever defend the said premises to the said. Mrs. W. G. Hawkins, her
assigns against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.
