H. McCollough, C. E., Greenville, S. C., reb. 24, 1906, shown as a ten foot alley set back 147.2 feet from First Avenue (known as Buncombe Road, now Poinsett Highway) running across a 54 foot lot fronting on Poinsett Highway of Joncas, Incorporated, purchased from Berry's, Incorporated on December 7, 1967 as shown on a plat of C. E. Riddle, Reg. C. E. of property of Berry's, Incorporated of Greenville, S. C., dated February 1966, revised November 3, 1967 recorded in Plat Book vvv-135 in the Greenville County Courthouse. And also all of our right, title and interest in that piece, parcel and lot of land as shown in Plat Book A, Page 109 of a plat of the property of Messrs. Cagle and Donaldson, Greenville, S. C., June, 1905, recorded October 13, 1905 of a ten foot alley setting back from First Avenue (known as Buncombe Road, now Poinsett Highway) 190 feet. The two above described alleys run across the lot fronting on Poinsett Highway for 54 feet into Hammett Street.

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
