Inman, Master, by deed recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 94, page 58. The said J. Wesley Key having conveyed his interest therein to Sara McI. N. Key by deed recorded in Volume 82, page 501, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina. The above property is the same property as that conveyed by J. C. Keys and S. McI. N. Key to Harry H. Jones, by deed dated January 11, 1929, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 148 of Deeds, page 8.
