and Michael Eugene Waters, in and to the following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on east side of road leading
from Landrum-Oak Grove Road to State Highway No. 14.

BEGINNING at corner of Billy Campbell land and running with Camp-
bell's line, S. 72 3/4 W. to the road about 85 yards; thence with line
of road north about 200 yards to Crowell Pitman home place tract; thence
with home place northeast about 114 yards to an iron pin in R. E. McClure's
