THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Wilton

Haskill Coggins

have constituted, made and appointed and by these presents do constitute, make and appoint

Edward Carroll Coggins, my

true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name and stead, and to

use, to ask, demand, sue for, levy, recover and receive all such sum and sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts, and other demands whatsoever, which are or should be due, owing or payable to me or detained from me

in any manner or ways or means whatsoever: and to handle all of my property, real or personal, wheresoever located, and to buy, sell, mortgage, pledge said property and to write checks and drafts and bills of exchange on any and all bank accounts and to use same in any way that he desires and to sell my car or any car, and property, real or personal if he so determines or desires to do so that I may own

Giving and granting unto Edward Carrol Coggins/<sup>my</sup> Attorney by these presents full and whole power, strength and authority, in and about the premises; Edward C. Coggins to have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name for the recovery thereof; and upon the receipt of any such debts dues, or sums of money aforesaid, acquaintances or other sufficient discharges, for me

and in my name to make, seal and deliver, and generally all and every other act and acts, thing and things, device and devices in law whatsoever needful and necessary to be done in and about the premises, for me and in my name to do, execute and perform, as fully, largely and amply, to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do, if I were personally present, or if the matter required more special authority than is herein given, and Attorneys, one or more, under this authority for the purpose aforesaid, to make and constitute and again at pleasure to revoke, ratify, allowing and holding, for firm and effectual, all and whatsoever which said Attorney shall lawfully do in and about the premises, by virtue hereof. this power of attorney to be in full force and effect until revoked by me in writing.
