expiring policies throughout the term, copies or certificates of any new or renewal policies, each bearing notations evidencing payment of the premiums or other evidence of payment satisfactory to the Trustee, shall be delivered by Lessee to the Trustee.

- (e) Policies of insurance provided for in Section 6.4(a) and any builder's risk insurance referred to in Section 6.4(c) shall name the County and the Lessee as insureds as their respective interests may appear, provided, however, that the Trustee shall also be named as a party insured pursuant to a standard mortgage clause as its interests may appear, and provided further that while any Bonds remain outstanding all insurance shall be payable as provided in Section 7.1 hereof.
- (f) All insurance required by this Section 6.4 shall be effected with responsible insurance companies selected by the Lessee. Lessee shall cause appropriate provisions to be inserted in each insurance policy making each policy noncancellable without at least ten (10) days prior written notice to the County, Lessee and the Trustee. Also, it is agreed that no claim shall be made and no suit or action at law or in equity shall be brought by the County or by anyone claiming by, through or under the County, against Lessee for any damage to the Project covered by the insurance provided for by this Section 6.4, however caused, but nothing in this sub-section (f) shall diminish Lessee's obligation to repair or rebuild as provided in Section 7.1. The Lessee shall have the sole right and responsibility to adjust any loss with the insurer involved and to conduct any negotiations in connection therewith, provided that so long as any Bonds re-
