the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

James W. Keller, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina situate, lying and being on the northeastern side of Sycamore Drive and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 118 and 119 of East Lynne Addition, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", at Page 220 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Sycamore Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 119 and 120 and running thence with the common line of said lots N, 28-50 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 118 and 119 S. 61-10 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Aniwetauk Street (formerly Johnson Street); thence with the northwestern side of said Street S. 28-50 W. 150 feet to an iron pin at the northwestern corner of the intersection of Aniwetauk Street and Sycamore Drive; thence with the northwestern side of Sycamore Drive N. 61-10 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
