

Beginning at a stake on the west side of the road leading south from the Greenville-Pelham Road toward the Roper Mountain Road at corner of Floride A. Hudson property and running thence with the said Hudson line S. 56-30 W. 1,320 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of W. H. Smith, S. 75-00 E. 782 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the center of the road leading from Greenville-Pelham Road to Roper Mountain Road; thence with the center of said road in a generally northeasterly direction 980 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
