in the State aforesaid _____ the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ROSALEE BRISBANE HARRIS, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real property, to-wit:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the city of Greenville, South Carolina and being known as Lot #14, Block A, of Glenn Farms as shown on the plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, August 26, 1943, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at the joint front corners of Lots #13 and #14 on Glenn Road and running thence N. 87-30 E. 115.2 feet to the joint rear corners of Lots #13 and #14; thence N. 87-30 W. 101.5 feet to the joint rear corners of Lots #14 and #15; thence S. 3 W. 119.5 feet to the joint front corners of Lots #14 and #15 on Glenn Road; thence with the Northern side of Glenn Road N. 89-20 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
