

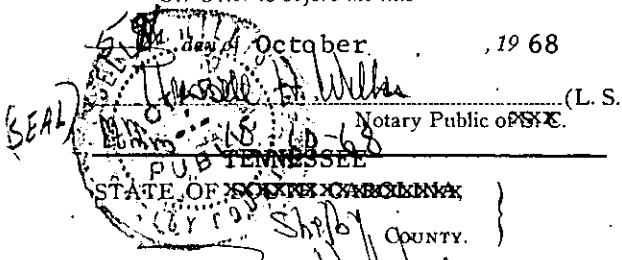

RENUNCIATION OF DOWER

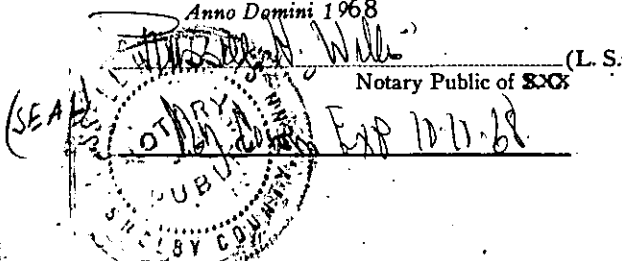
I, Russell H. Willis Notary Public for Shelby County, do hereby certify
