

(3) An easement for the benefit of the owners of the adjoining property on the east of the above described property, said adjoining property generally known as Lot 36, on the above mentioned plat, to use the common driveway located on the above described property so long as the common garage serving the above described property and the adjoining property to the east shall remain in use for private garage purposes and no longer.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the Grantee hereinabove named, and its Successors and Assigns forever.
