in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Etta T. Able, her heirs and assigns forever:

~~All that piece parcel or lot of land situate in Township Greenville County State of South Carolina~~

ALL of our undivided right, title and interest in and to that certain tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract No. 4 on Plat of C. O. Riddle dated April, 1964, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJJ, Page 21, the said tract having according to plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Bennett Bridge Road, common front corner with Tract No. 3 and running thence with Tract No. 3 S. 44-50 W. 1480.8 to an iron pin in Grady D. Neely property; thence with Neely property N. 4-52 E. 37.1 feet to an iron pin, continuing with Neely property N. 40-24 W. 280.7 feet to an iron pin, common rear corner with Tract No. 5; thence with Tract No. 5, N. 44-50 E. 1429 feet to a point in the center of Bennett Bridge Road; thence with the center of said road S. 45-10 E. 303.7 feet to the beginning corner and containing 10.06 acres.

Being the same property conveyed to Zion Thompson and others by Margaret W. Ross, Clerk, Greenville County Court, by deed dated June 2, 1965, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 775, at Page 40.
