KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Rosa D. Fisher,
and Katherine E. Fisher of Polk County, State of North Carolina,
William J. Fisher of Chesterfield County, State of South Carolina,
Mary F. Hartman of Fresno County, State of ~~California~~ Benjamin F.
Fisher of the City of Fredericksburg, State of Virginia, and
Mildred F. Plemmons of Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Ten and No/100
(\$2,010.00) Dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing
of these presents by Rock Spring Baptist Church of Glassy Mountain
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Rock Spring Baptist Church, its successors and
assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy
Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
adjoining the lands of Rock Spring Baptist Church, Della Plumley,
A. H. Lindquist, Archie Durham, John C. Fisher Heirs and more
particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the certain
tract or parcel of land conveyed to Rock Spring Baptist Church by
John C. Fisher, et als, by deed dated November 11, 1953, which has
been duly recorded in Deed Book 489, Page 283 in the Office of the
Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina,
and running thence with the line of said Rock Spring Baptist Church
tract three calls as follows: North 26 deg. 30 min. East 200 feet;
North 17 deg. 30 min. East 100 feet to a point in or near the center
of a private road leading to Rock Spring Baptist Church; North
76 deg. West 28 feet to an iron pin in the Southern margin of a
paved road, Della Plumley's corner; thence with Della Plumley's
line North 23 deg. 17 min. East (crossing said paved road) 82.3
feet to a nail and cap in Della Plumley's line in the center of
the pavement of Dug Hill Road, a corner common to A. H. Lindquist;
thence with the center of said road and with the Lindquist line
three calls as follows: South 52 deg. East 100 feet to a nail and
cap in the pavement; South 54 deg. 20 min. East 137 feet to a nail
and cap in the pavement; South 47 deg. 05 min. East 72.7 feet to
an iron pin in the center of said road in Archie Durham's line, a
corner common to A. H. Lindquist (said iron pin stands South 14 deg.
West 29.8 feet from an iron pin offset located on the Northeast
side of the Dug Hill Road in the line between the properties of
A. H. Lindquist and Archie Durham); thence with the Archie Durham
line South 14 deg. West (passing an iron pin in line at 30 feet)
231 feet to an iron pin in Archie Durham's line; thence North 78
deg. 12 min. West 314.3 feet to the beginning, containing 2.01
acres, more or less, and being the 2.01 acre tract as shown and
