the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Lewis E. Freeman, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 45 of a subdivision known as Watson Orchard as shown on plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, February, 1966, revised July 8, 1966 and December 28, 1966, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 000, at Page 99, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Highbourne Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 45 and 46, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 2-30 W. 210.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 44, 45 and 46; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 44 and 45, S. 83-45 W. 285.0 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Highbourne Drive; thence following the curvature of Highbourne Drive, the chords being N. 22-22 W. 109.05 feet, N. 18-45 W. 48.55 feet, N. 5-06 W. 63.73 feet, N. 40-00 E. 50.0 feet, N. 61-25 E. 50.0 feet, and N. 80-30 E. 75 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Highbourne Drive; thence along the southern side of Highbourne Drive, S. 77-50 E. 210.0 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to utilities easements of record and is also subject to restrictions and protective covenants recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 690, Page 531 as amended by subsequent restrictions recorded in Deed Vol. 758, at Page 116.
