BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Foster Drive, joint front corner of Lots 21 and 22, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 24-54 W. 234.9 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 13; thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, N. 56-11 W. 117 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 28-44 E. 221.7 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Foster Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with the southern side of Foster Drive, S. 62-15 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being one of the lots conveyed to us by Mary Ellen Woodside Wallace by deed dated May 22, 1968, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 844, at Page 473.
