the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Climelia P. Daniel, her heirs and assigns forever: All our right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in or near Greenville, in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 15, Section 1, as shown on plat entitled "Subdivision for Abney Mills, Brandon Plant, Greenville, South Carolina," made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., February, 1959 and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at page (s) 56 to 59. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 61 Dorsey Boulevard and fronts thereon 68 feet.

The above described property is the same conveyed to B. Worth Daniel (same as Boyd Worth Daniel) and Climelia P. Daniel (same as Nellie Climelia Perry Daniel) by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 624, at Page 240.
