to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) W. W. BRIDWELL, as TRUSTEE for JUNE BRIDWELL, a minor:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located about two miles north of Taylors, S. C., on the Eastern side of road (Highway No. S 23-337) which leads to Reid School Road and being shown on plat of property made for Mrs. Pearl (J. K.) Bridwell by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, dated Dec. 24, 1968, as lot number THREE (3), and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an nail in the center of said road at the joint front corner of lots 2 and 3, (iron pin set off at 24 feet on east bank of road) and running thence N. 84-36 E., for a total distance of 222 feet as the common line of lots 2 and 3; thence N. 7-40 E., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-36 W., 222 feet along other property of the within grantor to nail in center of said road (iron pin set back 20 feet on east bank of road); thence with the center of said road S. 7-40 W., 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a part of the same property received by Pearl Bridwell from will of her husband, J. K. Bridwell.

The said W. W. Bridwell, who is the father of June Bridwell is to hold title to the above described real estate as trustee for June Bridwell until she shall reach the age of twenty one, at which time to convey title to her. Nevertheless said W. W. Bridwell shall have the power to convey title, without court approval, before said June Bridwell shall reach the age of twenty one, to purchaser for value, he being the sole judge of value, and hold proceeds of sale for June Bridwell, until she shall reach the age of twenty one, without any purchaser of same being responsible or having the duty to look to application of proceeds.
