sell and release unto Jack E. Shaw Builders, Inc., its successors and assigns forever

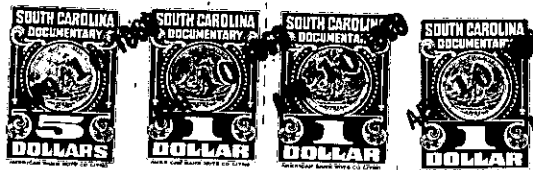
All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina on
