thence along her line and in the center of the old road, S. 79-1/4 E.
213 chains to a stake; thence S. 9-1/5 W. 24.80 chains to a point;
thence N. 65 W. 16.65 chains to a stake; thence N. 24 E. 22.60 chains to
the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to William
B. Feltman and Isabell A. Feltman by Deed of Dewey W. Quinn on October
