

It is understood and agreed that the right of way under this deed has a total length of 85 feet and is 10 feet in width running parallel with South Carolina State Highway right of way for South Carolina State Highway 291. The entire right of way may be used for the purpose of installing the pipe line and no obstructions shall hereafter be placed on the said right of way. The right of way is shown on a drawing dated June, 1969, labeled, "Water line right of way, Greenville Technical Education Center to The City of Greenville, South Carolina."

It is further understood that the grantor is to have the right to use this right of way strip of land provided such use thereof shall not interfere with the proper maintenance and free access to the pipe line to be installed under this agreement. No building or other structure shall be placed on said right of way.

The payment above specified covers compensation for the easement of right of way, and also covers all claims for damages, along said right of way resulting from construction of the pipe to be laid.

The undersigned agrees to release and give to THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, immediate actual physical possession of the premises above described.
