

INSPECTION OF RECORDS CLAUSE

Paragraph 17.

(a) The undersigned agrees that the Postmaster General and Comptroller General of the United States, or any of their duly authorized representatives, shall until the expiration of three (3) years after commencement of Government's basic lease term have access to and the right to examine any directly pertinent books, documents, papers and records of the undersigned or its successors and assigns involving transactions related to this Agreement to Lease.

(b) The undersigned further agrees to include in all its sub-contracts hereunder a provision to the effect that its subcontractors agree that the Postmaster General and Comptroller General of the United States, or any of their duly authorized representatives, shall, until the expiration of three (3) years after commencement of Government's lease term, have access to and the right to examine any directly pertinent books, documents, papers, and records of such subcontractors involving transactions related to the subcontract. The term "subcontract" excludes (1) purchase orders not exceeding \$2,500, and (2) subcontracts for purchase orders for public utility services at rates established for uniform applicability to the general public.
