I, Mattie C. Reynolds, a  
 resident of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,  
 do hereby name, appoint and constitute my two sons, namely:

Arthur William Reynolds

and

James L. Reynolds

jointly, severally and the survivor of them as my agent (s) and  
 attorney (s) in fact, either to act jointly together with each  
 other, or separately and alone, with full and complete power  
 and authority to do any one or more of the following things, in  
 my name and stead, to wit:

- (1) To receive and receipt for any money or other thing now or hereafter owing to me; and to pay any money, or to satisfy any obligation, that I may now or hereafter legally owe;
- (2) To open accounts with any bank, savings and loan associations, or other parties, and to make deposits therein; to close or make withdrawals from any account in any bank, savings and loan association, or other party with whom I may now or hereafter have an account;
- (3) To borrow money from any party, and pay interest thereon, and secure the payment of principal, interest, attorney's fees, and other customary items, by a mortgage or other lien creating transaction over any of my property, either real or personal, or both;
- (4) To bargain, sell, convey and transfer, any of my property, either real or personal, at any price, and on any terms and conditions, either for cash, on credit, or partly cash and partly credit, or partly or totally in exchange for other property; wherever situate;
- (5) To bargain for and buy any property, real or personal, at any price, on any terms and conditions, and on any terms and conditions, either for cash, on credit, or any combination of the two;
- (6) To make investments, without limitations, and re-investment, without exhaustion of power; and
- (7) To do any and all other acts and deeds that I might lawfully do in person.
