All of my undivided interest in and to all of those two parcels or lots of land in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, in the City of Greer, lying on the west side of Poplar Drive, and on the south side of Campbell Avenue, being shown on a plat made for Carl and Vernon Duncan by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor, dated September 14, 1960 and having the following courses and distances:
