KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, BERTHA E. BEASLEY

in consideration of love and affection Dollars,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

JAMES BEASLEY, his heirs and assigns forever

ALL my undivided right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, state and county aforesaid, as shown on a plat of property entitled Estate of Sam Beasley by Hugh J. Martin, Surveyor, dated December 12, 1968, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book SSS, at pages 152 and 153, containing 11.95 acres more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in Old Latimer Mill Road, joint corner of tract No. 1 and running thence along line of tract No. 1, S. 89-38 E. 733.27 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of tract No. 1; thence S. 61-40 E. 135.35 feet to an angle; thence S. 18-11 W. 206 feet to an angle; thence S. 02-59 E. 269.25 feet to a point in branch; joint corner of tract No. 3; thence N. 70-00 E. 706 feet to a point in Old Latimer Mill Road; thence with said road N. 17-47 W. 202.80 feet to an angle; thence N. 22 E. 652 feet to beginning corner.

The above is the same property conveyed to the grantee herein by deed of Mary Lou Beasley Pack, Elbert Beasley and Pearman Beasley, heirs of Sam Beasley, Deceased by deed dated January 25, 1969 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 860, at page 631. This deed is in correction to the deed referred to herein so as to reflect that all of the heirs at law of Sam Beasley, Deceased have conveyed their interests.
