In order that the Corporation may have a correct record of ownership of all lots where a re-sale and conveyance is made, it is required that the recorded deed shall be presented at its office so that a record of the transfer can be made. A fee of \$2.00 will be collected before any transfer of ownership is made on the Corporation. tion's records. The Corporation is governed by its records as to ownership of lots.

Where a lot is purchased and an extension of time is granted by the Corporation for payment, the Corporation retains ownership of the lot until all charges due it are paid, and the Corporation reserves the right to remove the remains which may be interred on the lot, to a smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the profession of the corporation smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the original, or to a single grave in the event that a default occurs in the agreed payment.

An order in writing is required of the lot owner whenever a grave is to be opened, containing the name, age, sex and residence of the deceased, and a permit from the Board of Health must be shown the Superintendent of the grounds before interment is made. If interment is to be made in the forenoon, application must be made before 2 oclock p. m. on the previous day. If in the afternoon, by 9 o'clock a. m. on the same day.

Lot owners shall at once notify the Corporation of any change in his or her post office address or name. No disinterment shall be allowed except upon order of the Executive Officers of the Corporation, and upon the written order of the owner or owners of the lot, and in every case can only be made under the supervision of the Superintendent.

No baskets, glass, crockery, wire, metal arches, watering pots, glass case, covering, box containing artificial flowers, or any sort of receptacle for flowers, except such as are sunk below the surface of the lawn for the grave or lot containing an inner apartment which may be lifted out while mowing the said lot, shall be permitted upon any grave or lot and all such as are not sunk below the surface of the lawn, grave or lot and all such as are not sunk below the surface of the lawn, grave or lot, may be removed by the

A visitor shall touch nothing in the cemetery that does not belong to him. Oraceland Cemetery, who are not members of a fungial procession, are required not to intrude upon a funeral or to folies about an open grave.

Entrance to and exit from the cemetery by vehicle or otherwise shall be by way of the regular established entrance place.

Vehicles are not to turn around upon any of the yeads, I should follow one of the circular driveways to their obsect. They shall keep on the right and when they stop shall be least six inches from the lawn. Vehicles shall not pass a funeral procession, nor shall the funeral be closely followed or joined by persons who are strangers. It is not an occasion for idle curiosity.
