SECOND AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS APPLICABLE TO A SUB-DIVISION KNOWN AS STONEWOOD, NEAR THE CITY OF FOUNTAIN INN, SOUTH CAROLINA, THE ORIGINAL PLAT OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN THE R.M.C. OFFICE IN PLAT BOOK WWW, PAGE 30, AND A SUBSEQUENT PLAT OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN THE R.M.C. OFFICE IN PLAT BOOK 4F, PAGE 13. THE ORIGINAL PROTECTIVE COVENANTS ARE RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 866, PAGE 166, AND AN AMENDMENT TO THEM IS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 882, PAGE 139.

WHEREAS, S. & W., INC. imposed certain Protective Covenants upon a Subdivision known as STONEWOOD, as shown on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book WWW at Page 30, said Restrictions being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 866 at Page 166; and,

WHEREAS, S. & W., INC. and M. L. LANFORD, JR. amended those Protective Covenants by an Amendment recorded in Deed Book 882, Page 139; and,

WHEREAS, there is no reference in the Amendment to the Protective Covenants to the place of recording the subsequent plat of the Subdivision.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and in order to refer to and describe the Subdivision property affected by the Protective Covenants and Amendment To Protective Covenants, as shown on the subsequent plat, this Second Amendment To Protective Covenants is recorded for the purpose of referring to the subsequent plat as recorded in Plat Book 4F, Page 13.
