All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the East side of Bahan Street, being a portion of the grantor's property, as shown on a plat thereof made by Charles Taylor and Bobby Grice, dated February 10th, 1970, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s)' heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee's(s)' heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
