ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northwestern side of  
Augusta Road (U. S. Highway 25) containing 33.55 acres, more or less, and being  
all of the land (except that hereinafter excluded) described in the following  
three deeds:

1. Deed from A. Traynham to J. A. Coker dated December 4, 1913, and recorded  
in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 28, at  
Page 307 by which 59½ acres, more or less, was conveyed.

2. Deed from T. W. Stansell to J. A. Coker dated March 13, 1928, and recorded  
in said RMC Office in Deed Book 136, at Page 221 by which 0.65 acres, more or  
less, was conveyed.

3. Deed from W. M. Boyce to J. A. Coker dated March 13, 1928, and recorded in  
said RMC Office in Deed Book 136, at Page 222 by which 0.71 acres was conveyed.

Included in the land described in the above mentioned three deeds to J. A. Coker,  
but specifically excluded from this conveyance are the following pieces, parcels  
or tracts of land:

1. 1 acre, more or less, described in a deed from J. A. Coker to Belton R. Coker  
dated March 19, 1936, and recorded in said RMC Office in Deed Book 188, at  
Page 25.

2. 2 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat of "Property of J. A. Coker Est."  
dated June 5, 1964, prepared by C. O. Riddle, RLS, recorded in said RMC Office  
in Plat Book GGG, at Page 205.

3. 24.31 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat of "Property of Charles W. Coker"  
dated October, 1969, prepared by C. O. Riddle, RLS, recorded in said RMC Office  
in Plat Book 4-D, at Page 65.

mentioned herein.

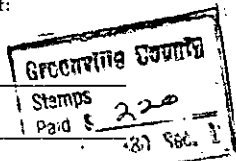
